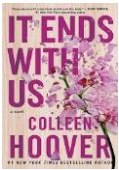

This novel of a love triangle with some very sharp edges reveals how those who love us can also hurt us.

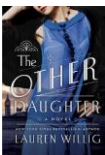


The Davenports

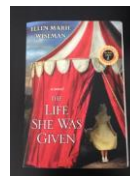


Britt-Marie was Here

The saga follows two young women, decades apart, both mistreated and trying to overcome childhood neglect and abuse.

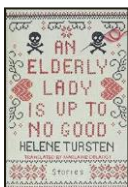


The Light Pirate

A mesmerizing coming-of-age story about one little girl in a time and place where nature is determined to assert her dominance over man.

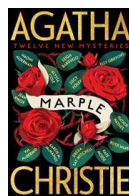


An Elderly Lady is Up to No Good

A funny and irreverent story about an irascible 88-year old Swedish woman with no family, no friends, and no qualms about a little murder.

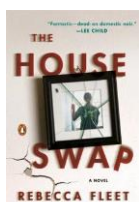


Marple: Twelve New Mysteries

Marital infidelity, drug addiction, house swapping, stalking, and a surprise ending add up to a psychologically suspenseful story.

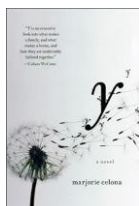


The Chain

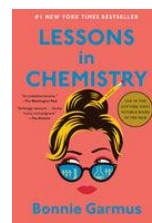


Y

As past and present converge, Y tells an unforgettable story of identity, inheritance and ultimately, forgiveness.

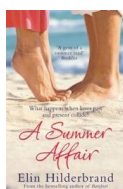


Lessons in Chemistry

A book that captures the love, loss, and limbo of an illicit romance and unchecked passion as it takes us on a brave and breathless journey into the heart of one modern woman.

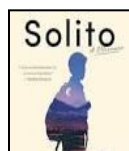


Big Little Lies
